It is a common desire of mankind to live in lasting peace and security. In spite of these universal desires, the expansion of nuclear armaments still continues and mankind is exposed to the threat of nuclear wars.

Japan, as the only atomic bomb experienced country, should appeal to world people for the threat of nuclear weapons and the sufferings of nuclear victims in order not to repeat the tragedies of Hiroshima and Nagasaki again.

We, citizens of Ichikawa, recognize the dignity of man's life, desire that our nation policy of the three non-nuclear principles is completely enforced, and appeal for the abolition and disarmament of all forms of nuclear weapons in all countries to establish permanent world peace. Ichikawa City hereby declares to be a city of "Peace Declaration for Abolition of Nuclear Weapons".
