

# Days and Number of Times of Garbage Collection to Change Starting April 2017!








- ☆ Please place all garbage at the designated collection point by **8:00 A.M. on the day of collection.** ☆ No collection of garbage and recyclable items on Sundays.
- ☆ Garbage and recyclable items (except large-size garbage) will be collected even on calendar holidays whenever those collection days fall on such holidays. However, these collection days will become irregular during the year-end/New Year period, so please check the Ichikawa Bulletin Flier or Ichikawa City Website for updated information.
- ☆ Please check the "district-based list of collection days" on the reverse side for your area's designated collection days, and fill in the blank squares.
