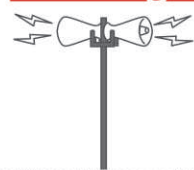

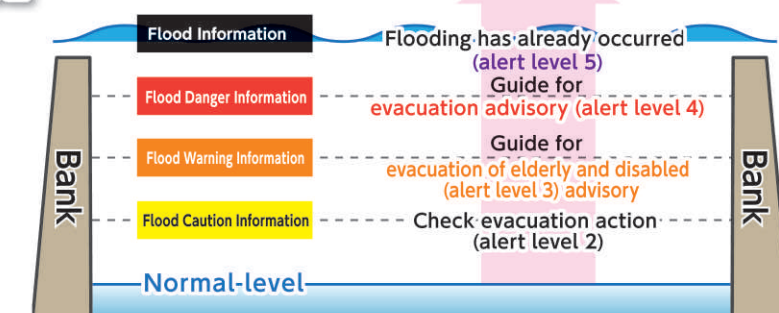
## 3 Self-evacuation

Evacuation information may be issued at night. Before the rain gets too heavy, self-evacuation is effective by evacuating to a friend's or relative's home in the area that is not expected to be flooded.



## 4 Information on river water level

The water level of the Edogawa River is defined as shown on the right, because if the river banks were to collapse, it would cause widespread damage. As flood waters collect in low-lying areas, you must pay attention to the water level upstream. The city government also checks the water level at a monitoring station in Noda.
