Large garbage (fee charged)

- Solid objects or metal objects, etc., over 18 L in volume.
- Five items per single application.

Examples of large garbage (plastic kerosene containers, dumbbells, metal barbells, etc.):
The total of all three sides (W+H+L) must be over 90 cm or over 24,000 cm³.

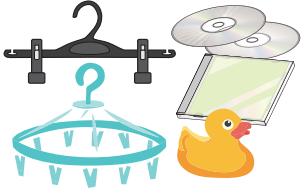
Please separate recyclables and garbage correctly and place them at the collection location by 8 a.m. on the collection day.

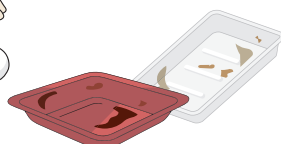
- Plastic products other than containers and packaging



- Food scraps



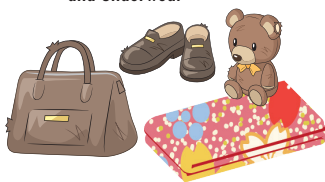
- Soiled plastic containers and wrapping

Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Place items in a designated bag for "Burnable Garbage". Drain the food scraps thoroughly before placing them in the designated bag.

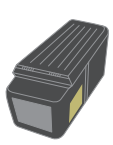

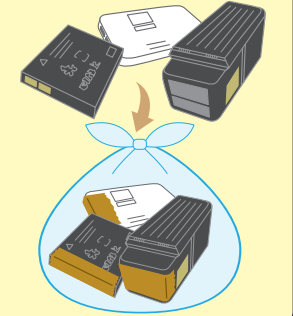

Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. **Insulate** the batteries by wrapping their ends in vinyl tape, etc., and then place them in a transparent bag or translucent bag which leaves the contents visible.

*If a battery is swollen or damaged, please bring it directly to the Solid Waste Management Division.



Plastic containers and wrapping

Items must have a plastics mark.

- Bottles and tubes

- Caps and labels

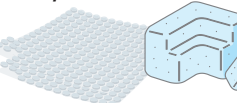


Disposal

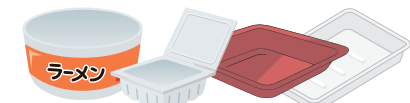
Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Empty the contents and lightly rinse the inside of the item, and then place it in a designated bag for "Plastic Containers and Wrapping".

- Broken items

- Spray cans (use up contents before disposal)



- Frying pans

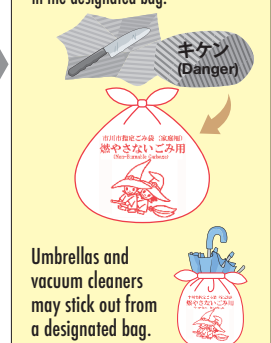


- Vacuum cleaners



Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Place items in a designated bag for "Non-Burnable Garbage". Wrap broken items and edged tools in newspaper or other similar material and write "キケン" (Danger) on the newspaper before placing them in the designated bag.

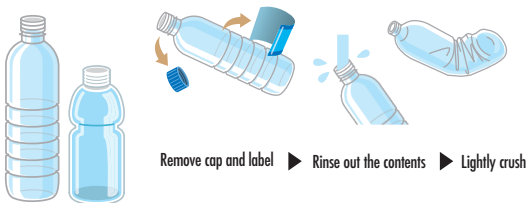


PET Bottles

Wed.

Items must have a PET mark.

- PET bottles



Disposal

Remove the cap and label, lightly rinse the inside, and then crush the bottle lightly before placing it in the net bag.

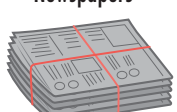


Papers

Mon.

Do not put out papers on rainy days. Limited to only 3 bundles per collection.

- Newspapers



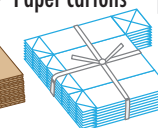

Disposal

Bundle each type of item and then tie string around the bundle to form a cross shape. Do not bundle items using adhesive tape, place them in a plastic bag, or put them together in a cardboard box. *Even a single piece of paper must be tied with string.

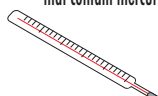
Hazardous garbage

- Fluorescent tubes



- Medical thermometers and blood pressure meters that contain mercury

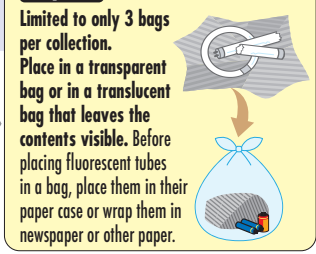


- Dry batteries



Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Place in a transparent bag or in a translucent bag that leaves the contents visible. Before placing fluorescent tubes in a bag, place them in their paper case or wrap them in newspaper or other paper.



Bottles and cans

Fri.

- Bottles



- Cans



Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Lightly rinse the inside of the item and then place it in a transparent or translucent bag or a designated bag for "Recyclable Bottles" or "Recyclable Cans". Separate bottles and cans.



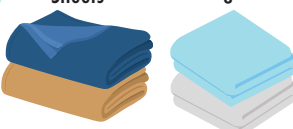
Textiles

Mon.

- Wearable clothes (including winter clothing and suits)



- Towel blankets and cotton goods
- Sheets



Disposal

Limited to only 3 bags per collection. Wash items and then place them in a transparent or translucent bag. Do not put out textiles on rainy days.

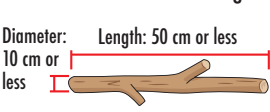


Pruned branches

Fri.

Limited to only 3 bundles per collection.

- Branches with 10 cm or less in diameter and 50 cm or less in length



Disposal

Gather branches in a bundle with a diameter of 30 cm or less and then bind the bundle with string.



Please cooperate in recycling small household appliances and rechargeable batteries.

We collect small household appliances, such as mobile phones, and lithium and other rechargeable batteries at collection points in city hall and other public facilities.

The city cannot collect or dispose of the following items



(1) Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators, freezers, cooling/warming boxes, and air conditioners) (2) Desktop personal computers (main unit), CRT displays (including integrated models), and liquid crystal displays (including integrated models) (3) Fire extinguishers (4) Propane gas cylinders (5) Motorcycles (including scooters) (6) Disassembled parts of automobiles and two-wheeled vehicles (7) Kerosene, gasoline, and oil (8) Pianos, fireproof safes (excluding portable safes), medicines, business equipment, soil, stone, and gravel (9) Residential medical waste (syringes, injection needles, and other sharp items, and medicines)
